April 13, 2025 It's the Gospel 1 Corinthians 15:1-11

1 Corinthians 15 continues to focus on disorder in the church. However, the emphasis shifts from disordered worship to disordered belief. The disordered belief centered around the resurrection. Some in Corinth, who believed in Jesus' resurrection, denied the resurrection of believers. To correct that confusion, a clear and succinct proclamation of the gospel of Jesus Christ must be made, with specific emphasis on the centrality of the resurrection.
