John 21:24-25

From the opening words, “In the beginning was the word,” John captivates his readers with the supremacy of Jesus Christ. Then for twenty-one chapters, John expounds on that supremacy. How then does John bring his gospel to an adequate conclusion? John succinctly ends his gospel with two statements of testimony: Jesus is true and Jesus is limitless.
