1 Corinthians 1:1-9 focus on the importance of the church. It is a reminder that, though their behavior is detestable, they are the church of God in Corinth. As God's church they need to be equipped to accomplish God's purpose. These verses tell us that God supplies His church with everything they need to be His church.
