Feast of Tabernacles John 7:25-52

John, more than the other Gospel writers, pays particular attention to the Jewish festivals. God commanded the festivals to be observed as a reminder of His goodness displayed toward His people. The Feast of the Tabernacles focused on God's protection and provision during the wilderness wanderings. It particularly emphasized God's provision of water in the desert wanderings. During this festival Jesus declared Himself to be the fulfillment of the Feast of Tabernacles.
