January 26, 2025 The Folly of Idolatry 1 Corinthians 10:14-22

Idolatry. Most Western Christians give little thought to idolatry, much to our danger. The danger is found in the spiritual reality behind idolatry. Behind idolatry is demonic forces and influence. Using the Lord's Supper as an example of how a believer fellowships with Jesus Christ, Paul forcibly argues any involvement with idolatry is communion with the demonic. Participation in the Lord's Supper bars believers from engaging in idolatry.
