Kingship of Jesus John 12:12-19

John 12:12-19 is the Triumphal Entry of Jesus into Jerusalem. Jesus enters the city following His anointing by Mary. Mary anointed Jesus for His impending death, not His elevation to king. However, the people who lined the streets rightfully recognized Jesus was the King of Israel. The Triumphal Entry of King Jesus reveals four aspects of His kingship.

3. How does Jesus' kingdom bring peace? How does Jesus' kingdom bring division? How do we reconcile Romans 14:17 with Matthew 10:34?

4. Why must we die to self to have life in Jesus' name? How does Jesus' triumphal entry fulfill John's purpose in writing his gospel?

5. How is the Holy Spirit leading you to respond to God today?
