Paul's final words in 1 Corinthians, reminds believers of the importance of right living based on right theology. The challenge is for believers to live according to our profession of faith in Jesus. Believers are encouraged to be missional, faithful, loving and grace giving. "The grace of the Lord Jesus," ends the letter as it began, reminding us our that salvation and greatest common bond is found only in Jesus Christ.
